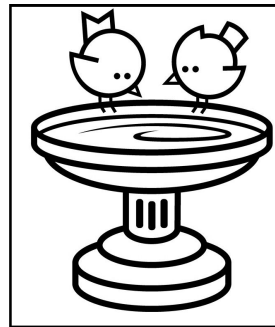
Our Lady of Hope Parish Library

Lobbying to Limit Religious Freedom

A network of wealthy donors is funding a series of well-organized lobbying campaigns to restrict legal protections for religious freedom at the federal, state, and local level. For some, the goal is to advance access to abortion and LGBT

causes. For others, the goal is revolution and tearing down Western institutions. One donor, Tim Gill, said, "We're going into the hardest states in the country. We're going to punish the wicked." Pennsylvania is a recent target.

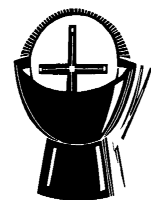
Donor George Soros-funded attacks are aimed at the small number of orthodox Catholic colleges and universities and focus on anonymous sources accusing faculty and some students of sexual assault. "We have long known that George Soros is the single most influential donor to dissident and anti-Catholic organizations," said William Donohue, president of the Catholic League.
