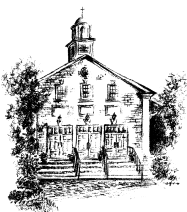

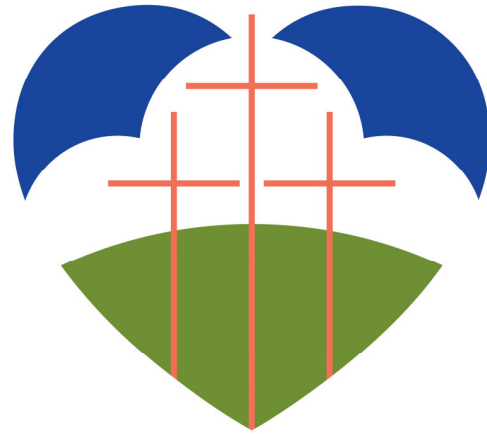
VIRTUS TRAINING-PROTECT OUR CHILDREN!
