In Europe, Father's Day was celebrated by the Ro-



man Catholic Church and countless Catholics since the Middle Ages. It was celebrated on March 19 in conjunction with the Feast of St. Joseph. Catholic immigrants, coming to North and South America, continued the tradi-

tion. In 1911 Americans celebrated Father's Day as an informal holiday in varying locales until 1924 when the day became more widely observed. In 1966 a formal Presidential Proclamation was issued and signed into law in 1972. It is with great joy and gratitude that we give thanks to God for the men we call Father, Dad, Grandfather and Godfather-yes, even Reverend Father! Happy Father's Day to all!
