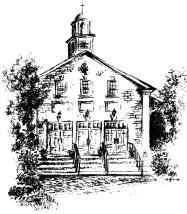

You alone are the true source of our cherished rights to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.*

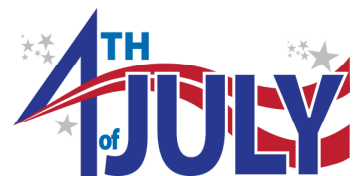
Reclaim this land for Your glory and dwell among Your people.

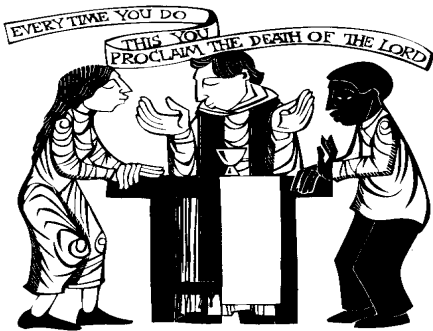
