LITURGY OF THE WORD

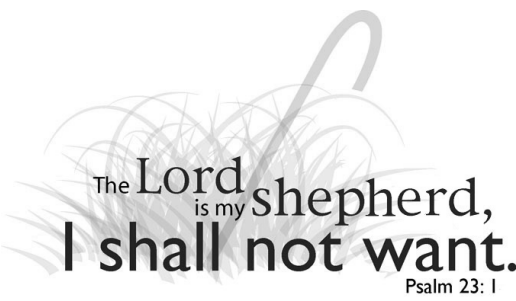
