#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

In Europe, Father's Day was celebrated by the Roman Catholic Church and countless Catholics since the Middle Ages. It was celebrated on March



19 in conjunction with the Feast of St. Joseph. Catholic immigrants, coming to North and South America, continued the tradition. In 1911 Americans celebrated Father's Day as an informal holiday in varying locales until 1924 when the day became more widely observed. In 1966 a formal Presidential Proclamation was issued and signed into law in

1972. It is with great joy and gratitude that we give thanks to God for the men we call Father, Dad, Grandfather and Godfather—yes, even Reverend Father! Happy Father's Day to all!

I am certain you are aware of Governor Cuomo's lifting of certain restrictions originally initiated in response to the pandemic. The most significant change is: Masks are now optional. For the good health and well-being of our parishioners, we encourage you to continue the practice of wearing a mask, HOWEVER, masks ARE NOT REQUIRED to be worn at worship liturgies. Furthermore, there are no more social distancing requirements.

The general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation Masses will end the weekend of Saturday/Sunday August 14/15, 2021.

What remains unchanged are the following: the exchange of the sign of peace will continue to be omitted, the holy water fonts will remain empty and there will be no entrance, offertory or recessional processions. Finally, Holy Communion will be distributed only under one species-the Body of Christ in the form of bread.



# **Our Lady of Hope Grotto - Memorial Garden**

4"x8" engraved brick memorials are now available for the brick pavement in front of the Grotto of Our Lady of Hope on the east side of the church. The funds raised as a result of this project will be used to complete the beautiful pipe organ in the church begun in 2002. The economic down turn and emergency repairs on the church building and systems, required a delay in completing the organ. While the entire organ has been in the building since 2004, there were only funds to have 1,500 of the 3,000 pipes working. The loudest sets of pipes were installed, leaving the softer sounds to be set up at a later time. Our organ is among the most beautiful on Long Island and is very unique in that it is built of "recycled heritage" parts, many over a century old. Our organ contains the choicest pipes of organs built by the best organ makers of the late 19<sup>th</sup> century through the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The magnificent carved oak case was formed of elaborate choir stalls from a former monastery chapel. The system which operates the keyboards and pipes is run by state of the art computers. Please consider memorializing a loved one, while at the same time helping the parish complete one of its most beautiful attributes.
