### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

The September 11 attacks, often referred to as 9/11, were a series of four coordinated terrorist attacks by the Wahhabi Islamist terrorist group al-Qaeda against the United States on the morning of Tuesday, September 11, 2001.

The physical destruction was only surpassed by the emotional heartbreak at the loss of innocent lives. Please remember to hold in prayer and thoughtful remembrance all who perished on that day as well as their families who mourn their loss. Please pray for all the First Responders, particularly Fire Fighters, Police Officers, EMTs, Fr. Mychal Judge, who rescued so many who were trapped and all those civilians who aided in the recovery mission, many of whom eventually succumbed to injuries or sickness sustained in the rescue operation and some who continue to suffer the ill effects of their work. Of the nearly 3,000 who lost their lives on 9/11, almost 500 were from Long Island. Just this past week, the remains of two Long Islanders were identified. Obviously, the pain for many families continues to this day. While the events are being introduced and taught in school curriculums, particularly throughout the tristate area, many of us remember precisely where we were when we heard the news of the attacks. Let us also remember the importance and value of life, that we might treat one another with love, respect, compassion, integrity and gestures of kindness every day!

**VIRTUS TRAINING-PROTECT OUR CHILDREN!**

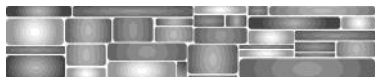
Virtus is a program that gives us a specific plan in identifying and preventing child sexual abuse. The training is required of all diocesan personnel and volunteers in all parishes.

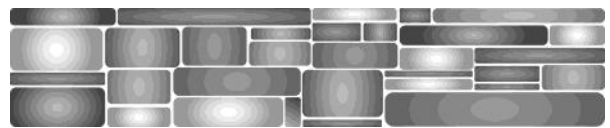
**OPPORTUNITIES TO REMEMBER LOVED ONES**

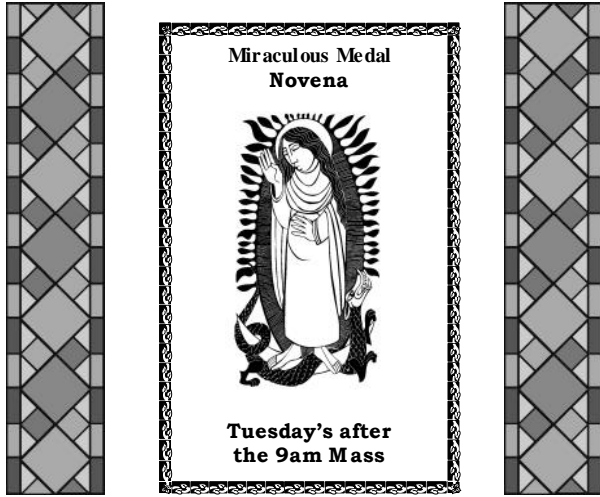

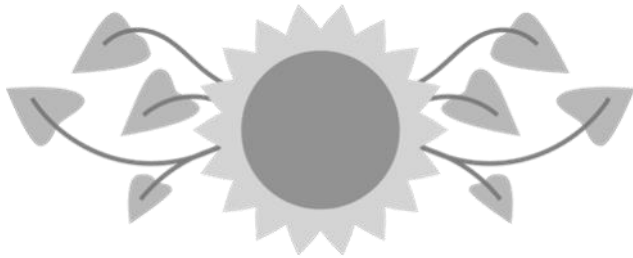
