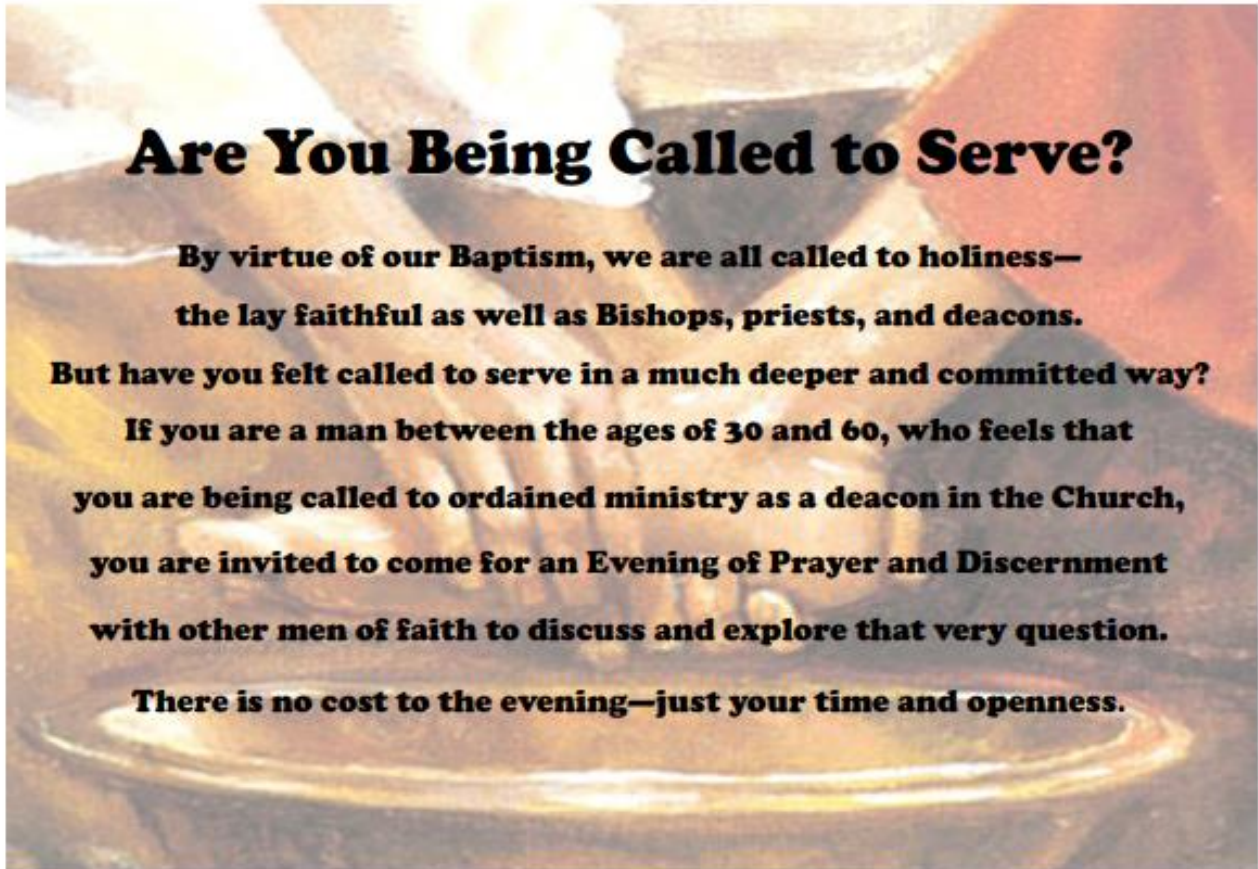

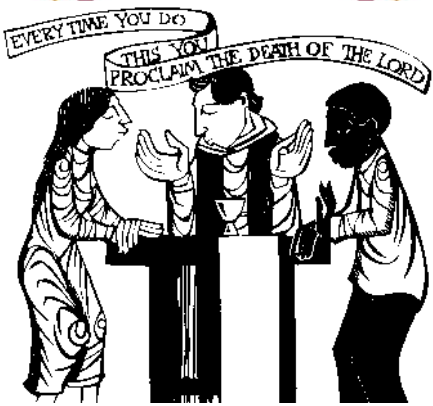
A plea from the Religious Education office:
