Peter calls them to repent and be baptized, and *about three thousand persons were added that day*. In the second reading, Peter writes of the suffering Christ endured that *we might live for righteousness*. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches that He is the shepherd and the gate who protects and guides His sheep.

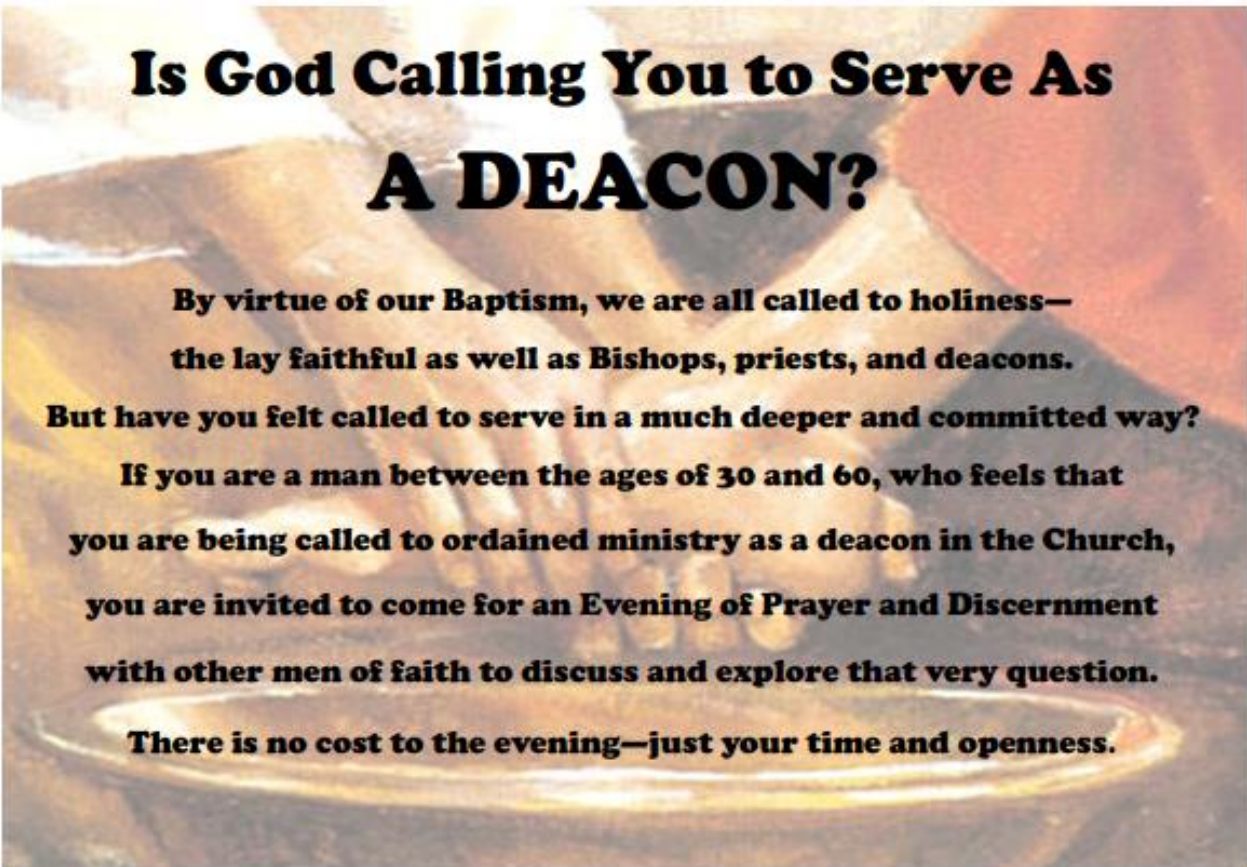

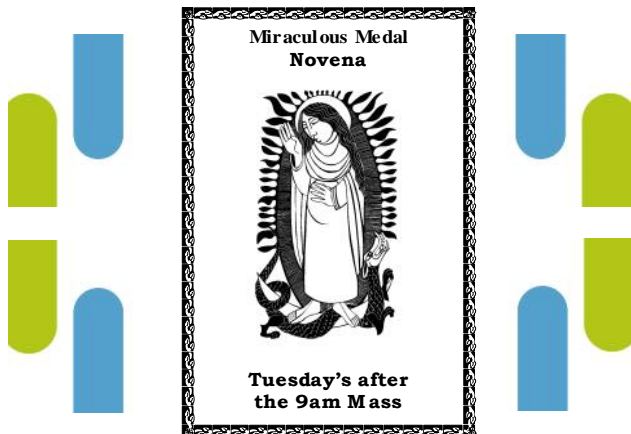
