Our Giving Garden is located in a sunny spot next to the playground. There are actually three distinct gardens. We have a vegetable garden, pollinator garden, and sensory garden. Any vegetables that we harvest are brought to the Parish Outreach Food Pantry. The pollinator garden is our response to the disturbing decline in the bee population. The sensory garden contains plants with different fragrances and textures. All are designed to give our students a variety of learning experiences, from preparing the soil to harvesting, from science to Catholic social teaching.


