



A SPECIAL MESSAGE FROM THE FOOD PANTRY STAFF




We apologize for leaving the Carle Place Fire Department off the list of donors. They are always supportive and always available to lend a hand. We appreciate their generous donation of gift cards.

We continue to thrive because of the generosity of you and the community. We are always looking for volunteers to join us. Contact the church office if you are interested. God Bless!






