In the first reading, the Holy Spirit descends upon the disciples with a powerful sound and upon each one in *tongues of fire*. Filled with the Spirit, they begin to speak about God's works in different languages so that visitors to Jerusalem are able to understand them. Paul writes about the way the Holy Spirit animates and unites the members of the Body of Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to His disciples, blesses them with His peace, and empowers them with the Holy Spirit to forgive and retain sins.

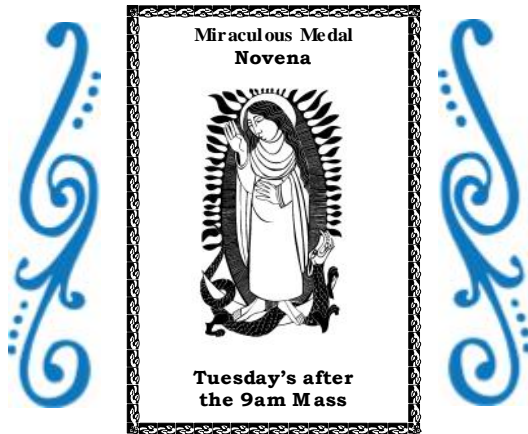
