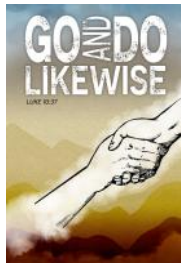
### WE ARE TO SEE OUR NEIGHBOR IN ALL PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY THE MOST VULNERABLE

June 1, 2025

Our Lady of Hope has developed a youth group that is scheduled to begin on Sunday, September 14<sup>th</sup> from 12:30 to 2:30. The program will challenge students to design, construct, test, re-engineer, and program robots to compete with other MS/HS students in Southern NY Vex Robotics Program. Working in groups, students will develop engineering manuals to keep accurate detailed information regarding the design, construction, programming, and changes in the development of their group's robot.



Each VEX robot will have four to five students working to compete in the VEX Robotics competitions task. VEX Robotics is a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) program and the World's Fastest-Growing Robotics

Competition for MS/HS students. Our Lady of Hopes program will re-enforcing a students ability to think and learn through their's as well as others mistakes.



Each session will be taught by a NYS Certified Technology Education teacher with the assistance of mentors and programming engineers, who all donate their time and talents to promote STEM hands on project based learning. Parental assistance is appreciated to assist students with their learning activities as well as supervision.

There is a \$75.00 cost associated with the program as the majority of the cost of the program is covered by Our Lady of Hope and a grant from the Frank J. Antun Foundation. 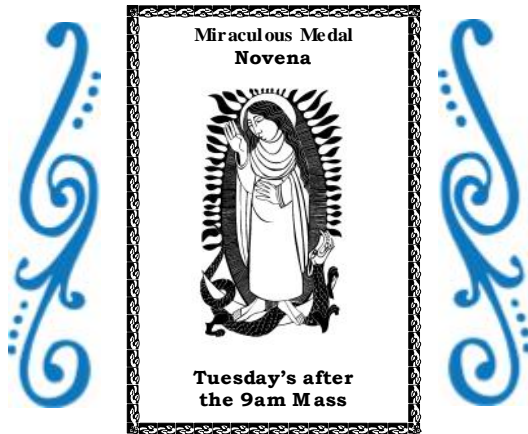
